Please contact your previous dental care provider(s) and have any recent x-rays sent to our office, as well as your last full mouth series and/or panorex radiographs. This will prevent unnecessary radiation exposure and costs to you. Please note that a full mouth series (and/or panorex) is generally taken only once every five years.

Your first appointment may require more than one visit depending on the following:

- The condition of your teeth and gums
- Your need for x-rays/radiographs
- An initial periodontal and restorative exam normally takes longer than future exams; it includes a comprehensive health history, blood pressure check, and charting periodontal measurements and existing dental work.
